ALBERTA CURRICULUM

Lilian Schick School follows the Alberta Curriculum. which specifies the knowledge and skills that students are expected to learn, set by Alberta Education.

LOGOS

LOGOS is a non-denominational Christian-based program offered in a nurturing setting, where children are taught to love God and others. It is part of the public school system and teaches the Alberta curriculum. LOGOS offers an excellent academic education enhanced by daily activities (prayer, scripture reading, praise), periodic chapel times and assemblies that build faith and fellowship.

LEADER IN ME

Leader in Me is an innovative, school-wide program offered at Lilian Schick School. Viewing every child as a leader, the program teaches students the 7 Habits of Happy Kids to instill responsibility, vision, integrity, accountability and teamwork.

ATHLETICS

In addition to sports-oriented complementary courses and the Hockey and Sports Leadership Program, our school offers basketball, volleyball, badminton, cross country and track and field.
