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### **6.2 Trustee Report**

- 1. 2021-2022 School Year Plan: The School Year Plan has been updated to reflect the January 5, 2022, Government announcement on changes in protocols for COVID-19. The School Year Plan is continually updated as changes are announced and will continue to be updated as more information is received. The updated version was sent out to all families and is on the website.
- 2. <u>School Ventilation Systems:</u> A letter was sent out to all SPS families via SchoolMessenger on Friday, January 7, 2022, with information on the ventilation systems in our schools. Since the pandemic started, ventilation has been one of our strategies to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. All of our schools meet or exceed the requirements outlined by the American Society of Heating, Refrigeration and Air-conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE).
- In response to the pandemic, the Division implemented the following:
  - Increased frequency of filter changes Maximized fresh air intake
  - Increased inspections of all school systems
  - Installed the highest quality filters possible

for each system

 Over the winter break, to prepare for the return of students, the Division started the process to change out all current school furnace filters. Updated recommendations from the Alberta chapters of ASHRAE also had us looking at how the Division could further enhance our systems.

- Based on updated ASHRAE recommendations, the Division has begun implementing the following additional measures:
  - • Adapt existing systems to fit MERV-13 filters
- Install in-room air cleaners with MERV-13 filters in systems where installation of MERV-13 filters is not possible.
- 3. <u>Draft K-6 Curriculum:</u> On December 13, 2021, Alberta Education announced that only three subjects (English Language Arts and Literature, Mathematics, and Physical Education and Wellness) of the draft curriculum would be implemented in September 2022 instead of all core K-6 subjects.
- 4. Hour-Zero: Sturgeon Public Schools' emergency preparedness program is called Hour-Zero, and the Emergency Response Plan is a preparatory measure. Statistics show schools are still among the safest places to be on a day-to-day basis; nevertheless, disasters do happen and because of that, no community can be complacent in its efforts to make its schools even safer.
- During any emergency, our first priority is the safety of our students and staff. There is an on-site emergency response team at each school, along with a Division-based Emergency Response Team that provides support and aid to schools at the time of an emergency. All staff is regularly trained on emergency protocols and drills are practiced at each school.
